5 years after its creation, Power the Nature redesigns its Logo, without changing its meaning or its symbolism which inspired the founders at the time of the birth of the project.


We take advantage of this updating of the logo to explain its meaning.

We have created a Logo with strong symbolism that can convey our energy and our commitments:



It is inspired by Leonardo da Vinci's Vitruvian Man, a symbol of Humanism which means "Man at the center of everything / Man at the center of the Universe". And we replaced the man in the center of the circle and the square, with a plant, which represents nature.

Our convictions are that we must give more importance to nature. Let's change our vision of Man at the center of everything, to give more importance to nature.
